- Amtrak's busy Northeast Corridor route
- Metro North loco hauled passenger trains
- Susquehanna Railroad loco facility

## **Ride**

- Long Island Railroad diesel loco hauled Oyster Bay line
- Trans Hudson Tubes
- New York Subway
- Hudson-Bergen Light Rail route
- Staten Island Ferry
- Metro North diesel service
- New Jersey Transit
- Newark Light Rail lines

- New York Transit Museum (housed in a closed underground station) featuring historic subway cars and artefacts
- Grand Central Station
- NJT's Hoboken Station
- Sightseeing "ground zero", Empire State Building and the waterfront
- Model Shop
